## The Jamz Tournament Rules

1. This tournament shall be known as “The Jamz Tournament,” conducted by Tournament Director, **Suheil Jammal, II**.
2. **Format:** Team event; (4) bowlers per team, all men, all women, or any mix. Bowl (3) games plus handicap based on 90% of the difference of the bowler’s entering average from 230, per game. This event is not USBC sanctioned. Scratch & Handicap Singles Options available; see Rule #8.
3. **Eligibility:** All bowlers must be 18 years of age or older. No USBC youth bowlers allowed. Only (1) PBA National Title holder per team OR only (1) PWBA National Title holder per team. Bowlers who arrive late/absent bowlers will receive a score of (0) until they are present and ready to bowl.
4. **Entering Average:** All averages must be 30 games or higher as posted on USBC’s bowl.com and Summer League averages will count, with the following considered in order or priority: (1) The highest average from the 2023-2024 season; (2) The highest average from the 2022-2023 season; (3) If no average is available from category (1) or (2), 2024 summer average may be utilized at the discretion of the Tournament Director, or the bowler will bowl scratch. All bowlers are subject to being re-rated at the discretion of the Tournament Director. If the Tournament Director feels a bowler’s entering average is not representative of their true potential, the bowler can be re-rated even if they have already bowled. In this case, brackets and high game pots will not be effected. However, the re-rate will apply to all singles options, including any squads previously bowled. This re-rate will also apply to all future squads and all future side action going forward. **IF ANY BOWLER DID, OR IS CURRENTLY AVERAGING, 10 PINS OR MORE ON THE 2023-2024 SEASON, THEN THAT AVERAGE MUST BE REPORTED AND WILL BE USED AS THE ENTERING AVERAGE FOR THIS EVENT.** Sport/Challenge averages will be utilized, with adjustment per USBC conversion charts.
5. **Squad Dates/Times:** Friday, August 23, 2024, at 5pm and 9pm; Saturday, August 24, 2024, at 12pm, 4pm, and 8pm; and Sunday August 25, 2024, at 12pm and 4pm. Friday, August 30, 2024, at 5pm and 9pm; Saturday, August 31, 2024, at 12pm, 4pm, and 8pm; Sunday, September 1, 2024, at 12pm, 4pm, and 8pm; and Monday, September 2, 2024, (Labor Day Holiday) at 12pm and 4pm. **ENTRIES OPEN MAY 19, 2024.**
6. **Lane Conditions:** The lanes will be stripped and oiled for each squad with the same house pattern as provided by Bowlero Altamonte, in consultation with the Tournament Director. No information will be made available about the pattern.
7. **Team Entry Fee & Break Down:** The entry fee, per bowler, per squad, is \$50.00, or \$200.00 per team. Of the \$50.00 amount, \$33.00 will be allocated into the team prize fund; and \$17.00 will be allocated for lineage/expenses. Promotional/free entries into some Optional Singles events may be provided to individuals sponsoring this event, or Team Group Leaders who field numerous teams.
8. **Singles Options: Men’s Scratch, Men’s Handicap, Women’s Scratch, Women’s Handicap, & Senior’s Handicap.** Bowlers may elect to participate in the Men’s Scratch Singles, Men’s Handicap Singles, Women’s Scratch Singles, Women’s Handicap Singles, and Senior’s Handicap Singles for bowlers age 50+. The same three games from the current squad will be utilized for the Singles options. The cost to enter each is \$25.00, and is payable in cash only for each squad you opt into on the day of each squad. Scores only count for each squad paid for. Of the \$25.00 entry fee, \$22.00 will go towards the prize fund, and \$3.00 will go towards Expenses.
9. **Sponsors:** The allocation of sponsor funds is at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Generally, sponsor funding is added to the Queen of Hearts game, unless otherwise requested by the sponsor.
10. **Entry Fee Methods & Deadlines:** To reserve your spots, you must contact me beginning on May 19, 2024. Call or text to 321-356-4290. USBC numbers must be provided for all bowlers. Zelle payment is accepted at 321-356-4290. I will also accept cash, check, or money orders in person. **Sorry, CashApp is no longer accepted. If you plan to mail in your entry, you MUST CALL ME at 321-356-4290, to ensure the squad is not sold out.** Checks or money orders are payable to **Suheil Jammal, II**. **Mail entries to Suheil Jammal, II, Tournament Director, 1108 Sweetbriar Road, Orlando, Florida, 32806.** There is no deadline to enter unless announced. Walk-in entries/re-entries accepted, pending availability, with payment in cash only. In some cases, a full payment may be required to reserve your spot, with no refunds offered. This is to curtail captains from casually over-booking spots, only to drop them late.
11. **Cash Ratio, Limitations, & Prize Fund Distributions:** Of the total team entries, 1 in 7 cash. Total pins plus handicap determines standings, from high to low, 1<sup>st</sup> place through the final paid position. If any team bowls more than once with the exact same four bowlers, they may cash once in the top 5 positions and multiple times in positions 6 and higher. For the Singles options, 1 in 7 cash, and bowlers may cash once in the top 5, and unlimited times in positions 6 and higher. In case of a tie for any position, in any event, including 1<sup>st</sup> place, prize monies will be added together and split evenly. For teams that cash, checks will be mailed to the Team Captain, upon which the Team Captain is responsible for that distribution. Checks will include all winnings (Team & Singles). For some, checks may be mailed directly to the individual bowler. Should any bowler cash for more than \$600.00, the bowler must provide proper information for possible IRS reporting/Form 1099 Miscellaneous Winnings before any checks will be dispersed.
12. **Optional “Side Action” Events:** \$5.00 Scratch & Handicap Brackets. \$40.00 High Game Scratch & Handicap Combo (includes all 3 games). \$10.00 Mystery Score (only available on final squad each day). “Quick Shot” (Strike) Jackpot. And the “Queen Of Hearts” game. Complete rules for these events will be posted at the check-in table. The Quick Shot Jackpot is partially explained below in rule #13. Complete rules for all side action events will be available at the Tournament.
13. **Quick Shot (QS) Jackpot Partial Rules:** These are partial QS rules; complete rules will be available at the check in table. The QS requires a minimum buy-in of \$5.00 per raffle ticket; no limit. One ticket will be drawn. The bowler holding the ticket must strike the next time up in tournament play, and if so, the bowler wins the jackpot. If no strike, bowler receives a consolation prize, and a 2<sup>nd</sup> ticket is drawn. Strike to win it all, or get a consolation. **PLEASE NOTE: If two tickets are drawn, and neither bowler strikes, the balance rolls over into the next squad of the tournament with one exception. If the QS is not won on the Sunday, August 25, 2024, 4pm squad, or the Monday, September 2, 2024, 4pm squad, additional tickets drawn will be drawn until won. There are no carryovers allowed from one weekend to the next.** At the discretion of the Tournament Director, some squads may feature a seeding of the jackpot pool before tickets are sold, and this will be announced prior to that squad starting. In the event of a large carryover/heavy sales, the jackpot pool may be allocated into more than one jackpot. No less than 80% of sales comprises the jackpot for each squad, plus carryover, if any. Approximately 5% or more will be allocated to the “Queen Of Hearts” game (See rule 15.) Approximately 15% or less goes to Tournament Expenses.
14. **Queen Of Hearts Game: Partial on the WEBSITE: TheJamzTournament.com.** Complete rules will be available on site.
15. Any other situations not covered here will be rendered by the Tournament Director, Suheil Jammal, II, and those decisions shall be final.
